If you get to the level of 1st Mate and start leading sailing, we will allow you to put "Sailing Instructor for 3rd Coast Cruising" on your sailing resume, with that addition you will be able to rent a sailboat just about anywhere in the world - Navigation Classes are very important for this as well.

tickets to the annual Strictly Sail Show at Navy Pier.
